TIMING / RESULTS

The timing is measured with an electronic timing system and uses a contactless active transponder. Every participant has to wear the transponder above the ankle during the whole competition. Immediately after reaching the finish line the transponder has to be handed over to a staff member. Without transponder no time will be measured.

In case of loss or non-return of the transponder 80,-€ must be paid.

SERVICE

- Shower and washing-up facilities are available on the transition/beach area and by the camping side, relaxation points available on side (massage treatments)
- Comprehensive medical assistance on the track and in the transition area through the "German Red Cross", the water life guards and the mountain rescue service "Zittauer Gebirge" and a medical doctor responsible for the O-SEE CHALLENGE competition
